



**Jérôme Lohez 9/11 Scholarship Foundation
Partnership with Sciences Po-Fudan University
Graduate Dual-Degree Program on Europe and Asia in Global Affairs**

The **Jérôme Lohez Foundation** was launched in November 2005 in honor of Jérôme Robert Lohez, a French citizen who passed away in the North Tower of the World Trade Center on Sept. 11, 2001. The foundation's mission is to foster international unity and cultural understanding by supporting graduate academic exchanges in higher education, in honor of those diverse citizens who perished in the 2001 attacks in New York City.

The **Graduate Dual-Degree Program on Europe and Asia in Global Affairs** is a transnational joint-venture between Sciences Po in France and Fudan University in China.

The universities have partnered with the Jérôme Lohez 9/11 Scholarship Foundation to open scholarship opportunities for all students who are enrolled in the graduate dual-degree program. The first year of study will take place in Paris, and the second year of study will take place in Shanghai.

Jérôme Lohez 9/11 Scholarship applicants will be screened by the foundation's executive board of internationally qualified professionals and academics.

The deadline for applications will be **October 15, 2018**. The board will meet to review submissions and scholarship winners shall be announced in early **November 2018** via the Lohez Foundation [Website](#) and also on its [Facebook](#) page. The award presentation reception usually is held at the French Consul's residence in Shanghai.

Guidelines

- The foundation may provide scholarships to:
- Students to obtain a Master on Europe and Asia in Global Affairs dual-degree from Sciences Po in France and Fudan University in China
- The award is RMB 10,000
- Applicants must have an undergraduate degree.

For graduate applicants wishing to complete their Europe and Asia in Global Affairs studies during one year in China and one year in France:

Applicants must submit two essays:

- Pursuing ideals of international understanding and cooperation through graduate study abroad. Do these ideals inspire you to study equally in France and China, and in what way?
- During your international study experience, how will you encourage opposition to global, violence-based ideologies?

Other application materials

- Along with their essays, applicants must submit a cover letter and three letters of recommendation: one academic reference, preferably by a professor who taught the applicant; one from an employer, preferably by a direct supervisor of the applicant; and one from a close associate who can describe the applicant's personal character. Letters of recommendation should be signed by the writer and should include the contact information of the recommender.
- A Basic Information Sheet is downloadable in PDF from the application site; and once completed, it can be uploaded at the appropriate place on the application site.

- Academic records are mandatory. Applicants must submit their transcripts from all colleges that they attended. Transcripts must carry an official seal, and applicants shall direct the registrars' offices to send transcripts to our foundation.

- The time-stamp deadline for submission of all materials is **October 15, 2018**. Late applications will not be considered.
